


PCP office, Urgent Care or Emergency Room Where Should You Go?

- Same Day Care
- Cold or flu
- Sore throat
- Rash
- Medication Refill
- Medication Questions
- Vaccinations
- Routine Visits
- Physical Exams
- Chronic Issues

URGENI CARE

Call PCP first then may be sent to Urgent Care

- o Fever greater than 101.5 F
- o Earache
- Urinary Tract Infections
- Migraines
- High Blood Pressure
- Accidents/Falls that result in mild or moderate injuries
- Anxiety Attack
- Lower Back Pain

EMERGENCY ROOM

Call 911 or go to the nearest Emergency Room

- Chest Pain or Pressure
- Sudden severe pain
- Sudden or Worsening Shortness of Breath
- Accidents/Falls that result in serious injuries
- Bleeding that will not stop
- Sudden changes in weakness, change in vision, loss of balance
- Sudden dizziness with no relief
- Stroke Symptoms
 - Face Droop
 - Inability to equally raise both arms
 - Slurred speech
